| <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. No tires, batteries, or motor oil. 2. No paint cans, including spray paint cans. 3. No chemicals of any kind. 4. No household garbage. 5. NO DOUBLE AXLE TANDEM TRAILERS. 6. No construction or remodeling materials, i.e. roofing, wood, shingles, sheetrock, carpet, carpet padding, etc. 7. No concrete or brick. 8. No grass clippings, leaves, or pine straw. 9. No licensed vehicles (motorcycles, scooters, etc.) 10. Large objects (i.e. swing sets or camper covers) must be dismantled before dumping. | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 11. 55-gallon drums with lids or without lids are not accepted. 12. All nails, screws, and hardware MUST be removed from fencing materials. 13. Tree limbs must be less than six inches in diameter and no longer than six feet in length. 14. Tree limbs must be unloaded in the proper dump area, and all fencing MUST be placed inside the proper dumpster. 15. Constituents are limited to ONE LOAD per day. |
